## ‘HAL, ISRO will play a significant and positive role in the future of India’

President Droupadi Murmu inaugurates Integrated Cryogenic Engine Manufacturing Facility at Hindustan Aeronautics Limited

When India celebrates 100 years of its Independence in 2047, the world around us would have changed drastically and we cannot visualise how Artificial Intelligence (AI) and automation are going to transform lives in the next 25 years, said President Droupadi Murmu on September 27.

“Just as we were in no position 25 years ago to imagine the contemporary world, we cannot visualise today how artificial intelligence and automation are going to transform our lives. We are looking ahead at the next 25 years as the

period to re-imagine India and make it a developed country,” she said while inaugurating the Integrated Cryogenic Engine Manufacturing Facility of Hindustan Aeronautics Limited (HAL) in Bengaluru.

The Integrated Cryogenic Engine Manufacturing Facility can manufacture cryogenic and semi-cryogenic Engines.

Addressing the gathering, the President said the opening of the facility is a historic moment not only for HAL and ISRO, but for the entire country.

Being the force behind the forces, she said, HAL has contributed immensely to the country's self-reliance in defence in terms of research, development

and manufacturing of various aircraft platforms. President Murmu complimented ISRO for its sincere efforts and contribution toward making India

the sixth country in the world to have cryogenic engine manufacturing capabilities.

“HAL and ISRO together contribute to strategic defence and development. The glorious past of HAL and ISRO gives us an assurance that these organisations will continue to play a significant and positive role in the future as India enters the Amrit Kaal,” President Murmu added.

**Virology institute to come up in Bengaluru**  
President Murmu also laid the foundation stone for the Zonal Institute of Virology (South zone) through video-conferencing.

“Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR) pro-

vided exemplary support for effective COVID-19 management and is expanding its research infrastructure,” President Murmu said.

National Institute of Virology, Pune, under the Indian Council of Medical Research, is taking all possible steps to increase R&D in the field of virology. The National Institute of Virology has been designated as one of the collaborating laboratories of the World Health Organisation, President Murmu said. “The expansion of National Institute of Virology through zonal campuses across the country, to cater to the demand in the various regions, is praiseworthy,” she said.

## Train students to be future ready, Murmu tells educational institutes

President Draupadi Murmu on Tuesday said educational institutions in the country should train their students to become “future ready” according to the changing times. The country will have the highest number of young people in the world over the next decades and the ability to provide high-quality educational opportunities will determine their future and the future of our country, she said.

The President was speaking at the inauguration of St. Joseph's University in the city.

**Aspirational generation**

“It is the responsibility of educational institutions to train and equip their students in such a way that they are prepared for the demands of the future,” she said adding that the young population today are very aspirational and universities need to respond to these diverse aspirations.

Ms. Murmu said that to cater to the aspirations of the students,

universities need to adapt out of the box thinking. “The National Education Policy 2020 is one such effort to make academics align with the changing needs.”

She said many of the students look towards the West for higher learning and research and that efforts should be made to make the country's universities globally competitive so that the students get opportunities all over the world. She noted that many Indian institutions have earned a place in international rankings but their number is very small. She also said that it should become the aim of every Indian educational institution to become a centre of world class learning.

**140-year-old institution**

Under the Rashtriya Uchchathar Shiksha Abhiyan scheme, the 140-year-old St Joseph's College (Autonomous) was granted the university status in July 2022. During the inaugural ceremony, Governor of Karnataka Thawar Chand Gehlot, Chief Minister Basavaraj Bommai, Bengaluru

Archbishop Peter Machado and Chancellor Dionysius vaz SJ were also present.

Speaking at the event, Mr Bommai said that there is a paradigm shift in the levers of power and knowledge had become the real tool. Recalling how Britain invaded different countries for power, he said, “The 21st century is not the time for land and money, it is only for knowledge. Previously, all premiers of different countries used to come to Delhi, but now they do not. They come to Bengaluru. Even here, they do not come to Vidhana Soudha, but go to Infosys and Wipro.”

The CM also praised the St Joseph's University for standing the test of time for over a period of one century. “It has been a part of the growth of not just Bengaluru, but entire Karnataka. It has given excellent students to society who have excelled to the best of their abilities in various fields.”

The President was offered a civic reception at Banquet Hall at Vidhana Soudha. She leaves Karnataka after a three-day visit on Wednesday.

## Inter-State drug racket unearthed; five arrested

The CCB on Tuesday busted an inter-State narcotics ring and arrested four women and a foreign national and seized drugs worth ₹7.8 crore. The accused, Pushpa, Vijaya, Devi, and Poornima, were caught by the sleuths outside Puttaparthi railway station while

they were waiting for their contacts to deliver the consignment.

The police raided the house of a foreign national, David John, and recovered 1.4 kg of MDMA crystals from him. Investigations revealed that the narcotics were being supplied to peddlers from a kingpin living in a tribal village, Seetampalli, and Araku forest area in Andhra Pradesh.
