Dr. Lakshmanan Chittur Chandrasekharan received PhD in Chemical Engineering in 1983, IISC, Bangalore, India. He has 39 years (14 years in Australia & 25 years in India) of post PhD experience in Industrial R&D, Technology Development and Innovation for Oil & Gas Exploration and Production, Reservoir Engineering, Offshore Structures, Coalbed Methane, Hydraulic Fracturing, Steel Industry, Iron Ore Mining, Fast Moving Consumer Goods, Advanced Materials (Plastics, Silicones, Specialty Materials), Agricultural sciences including Silviculture, Pulp and Paper, Packaging & Biosciences. He has built two world-class industrial R&D organizations in Bangalore, India. General Electric's John F Welch Technology Centre, Bangalore (5000 researchers) and ITC Life Sciences & Technology Centre (400 researchers). He has implemented multiple technologies for BHP, GE & ITC. During his tenure, ITC filed 950 patents. He has qualified Six Sigma Master Black Belt (General Electric Certified). He also mentored 40+ Six Sigma Green Belts & 9 Six Sigma Black Belts globally. He was a Chief Scientist in Research & Technology Innovation and Head of R&D of ITC Limited. He served as a Director, Technical & later Director and Manufacturing Engineering General Electric. He was a Deputy General Manager of Exploration & Production in Reliance Industries. He also served as Senior Research Officer, BHP Research & New Technology. His latest book in 2021 was on "Go Green for Sustainability" by Taylor & Francis. Father Xavier is a Ph.D Supervisor under the University of Calcut-ta, Viswabharathi (Tagore's Shantiniketan University) and an examiner of Ph.D thesis for many Universities in India. His feather in the cap was when he delivered lectures at the University of Oxford and at the United Nations' Climate Summits while attending the famous COP 21 in Paris, France and COP 23 in Bonn, Germany. As a prolific writer, he has published research papers in journals of national and international repute.
