Karnataka on Thursday became the latest State to join the others keen on implementing Assam-like National register of Citizens (NRC). Speaking to reporters here on Thursday, Home Minister Basavaraj Bommai said Karnataka was seriously considering NRC. "We are one of the states where people from across the border have come and settled down. We are discussing the issue with Union Home Ministry and will take a call," he said.

The minister added that a large number of people have come from other countries, particularly Bangladesh, and settled in Bengaluru and other cities of the state. "Some of the immigrants have even been involved in criminal and other illegal activities. This has come to our notice," he said. "After discussing the pros and cons, we will take up the issue of NRC with the Union Home Ministry," he said.

Karnataka's proposal comes close on the heels of Union Home Minister Amit Shah's pitch for NRC across the country. The State governments of Uttarakhand, Haryana, Uttar Pradesh, and Jharkhand, all led by the BJP, have also expressed interest to implement NRC in their States.
