India to give Covid-19 vaccines to Canada

rime Minister Narendra Modi confirmed India would send vaccines to Canada, hours after talking to his Canadian counterpart, Justin Trudeau over the phone.

Trudeau said if the world managed to conquer Covid-19, it would be significantly because of tremendous pharmaceutical capacity.

He praised Modi's leadership in sharing India's pharmaceutical capacities.

"India would do its best to facilitate the supplies of Covid-19 vaccines sought by Canada," Modi wrote on Twitter late on Wednesday night after his conversation with Trudeau.

He thanked Trudeau for his sentiments and also said both countries agreed to continue to collaborate on other important issues like climate change and global economic recovery from the pandemic.

The leaders also reiterated the geopolitical issues and the common perspectives of both the countries over it and are looking forward to meeting each other on various important international fora, in the later part of the year and discuss issues of mutual interest.
